# Thanks to you, in 2018-19:

**843** men experiencing homelessness for the first time received help—**80% were quickly reintegrated into the community**

**545** women were welcomed into our Patricia Mackenzie Pavilion, including 305 who were new to our services

**461** young men and women, aged 18 to 35, received services adapted to their needs. Nearly 28% of our clients are young adults

**260** homeless men and women received adapted psychiatric care onsite at the Old Brewery Mission

**300** affordable, long-term housing solutions in Montreal were adapted to the needs of homeless individuals

**298** men and women on average were welcomed each day at our Café Mission Keurig®

**29** homeless women moved into their own apartments as part of our *Voisines dans la communauté* affordable housing program

**15** women stayed at our new *Maison des voisines de Lanaudière*, which includes 10 units in the heart of the Plateau Mont-Royal

**335,557** nutritious meals were served—an increase of nearly 13,000 meals compared to last year

**30,000** items of clothing were distributed

# At the Mission, we believe in the power of partnership.

In 2018-19, we continued to deepen our alliances while fostering new ones. The following page features positive outcomes made possible by working side-by-side with our partners towards a singular goal: **ending chronic homelessness in Montreal.**

## HOUSING

**250** previously homeless men and women have been housed since the start of *Projet Logement Montréal (PLM)* in 2016—an innovative consortium among the Old Brewery Mission, Maison du Père, Accueil Bonneau and Welcome Hall Mission.

**93% of residents have successfully reintegrated into the community. Today, PLM is considered the biggest program of its kind in Canada.**

By 2022, PLM aims to house an additional 138 people experiencing homelessness in Montreal, including 60 in social housing. A new partnership with the *Office municipal d'habitation de Montréal* and others from the health and social services network will make this possible.

This year, we deepened our collaboration with *Projets Autochtones du Québec* to offer culturally adapted support and affordable, permanent housing to 10 Aboriginal individuals experiencing homelessness. This initiative, long overdue, is a promising first in the Mission's 130-year history as we continue to build mutual trust and understanding.

## VETERANS

**16** veterans have been housed since the start of our *Sentinels* program in partnership with the federal government and the *Quebec Veterans Foundation*.

**88% of veterans remain housed and have successfully reintegrated into the community.**

The *Sentinels* has gained national attention for being the first permanent housing initiative of its kind in Quebec aimed at veterans who are homeless or precariously housed.



**Daniel, a veteran, was living in substandard and unsafe housing.**

He found himself at the Mission for a hot meal and quickly learned about the *Sentinels* – the only housing program in Quebec for homeless veterans. Today, Daniel lives in an apartment he's proud to call home while receiving the support he needs to reintegrate into the community. "I take life one day at a time," he says.

## MENTAL HEALTH

**44** beds across three Montreal organizations are now designated to men and women who are homeless and living with serious mental health conditions.

This year, we successfully expanded our *Projet de réaffiliation en itinérance et santé mentale* (PRISM) program, which provides sustained access to adapted psychiatric services for homeless people with serious mental health issues, in partnership with the *Centre intégré universitaire de santé et de services sociaux (CIUSSS) du Centre-Ouest-de-l'Île-de-Montréal* and the *CIUSSS du Centre-Sud-de-l'Île-de-Montréal*.

It's at the Old Brewery Mission, in front of a room crowded with guests, journalists and partners—including Martine Turcotte, Bell's Vice Chair Québec, and Montreal Mayor Valérie Plante—that Bell Let's Talk announced a \$300,000 donation to Accueil Bonneau, Welcome Hall Mission and the Old Brewery Mission to support our work of reintegrating people coping with homelessness and mental illness into the community.



In 2013, we partnered with the CHUM to launch the *Projet de réaffiliation en itinérance et santé mentale* (PRISM Cogeco), an innovative model of care to improve outcomes for people who are homeless and diagnosed with chronic mental illnesses.

France decided to give back by sharing her story with the world.

A new video featuring France, a PRISM participant, was a highlight of the press conference. After watching her touching testimonial, guests spontaneously turned towards France to applaud her. France gave numerous media interviews at the end of the event. Today, she lives at our Lise Watier Pavilion.



## POLICE TRAINING

**880** police officers completed our training sessions and gained a better understanding of the realities faced by people experiencing homelessness in Montreal.

Our research department is currently working with the University of Toronto to evaluate our model for training SPVM staff on improved interventions with homeless individuals.

## SHELTER OVERCROWDING

**80** new emergency beds were made available at the old Royal-Victoria Hospital to relieve the overcrowding that occurs every winter in Montreal's overnight shelters—the result of our collaboration with Welcome Hall Mission, Maison du Père, Accueil Bonneau, the City of Montreal and the provincial government.

In February 2019, our Research Department began a study to evaluate this initiative and to gain a better understanding of those who used this temporary service.
